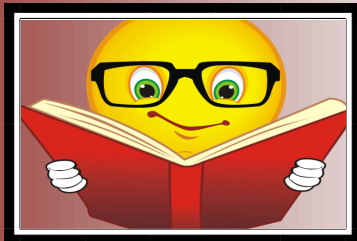


### Stop! Wait for It! Come and Browse! Christmas is coming!

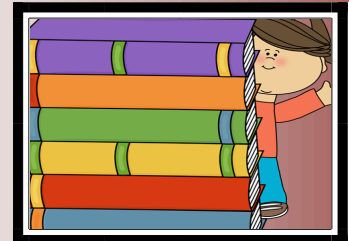

So, once again mark your calendars as this is a great opportunity to fill those stockings!

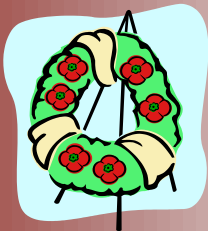
