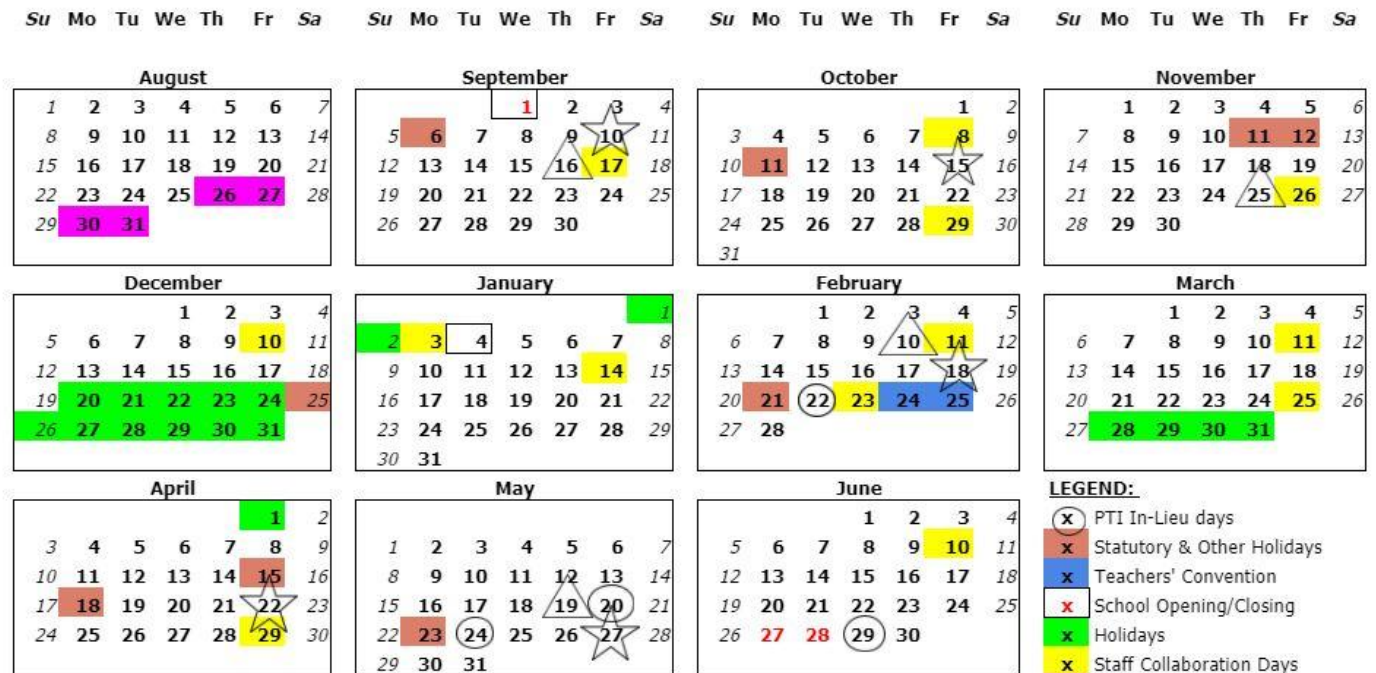

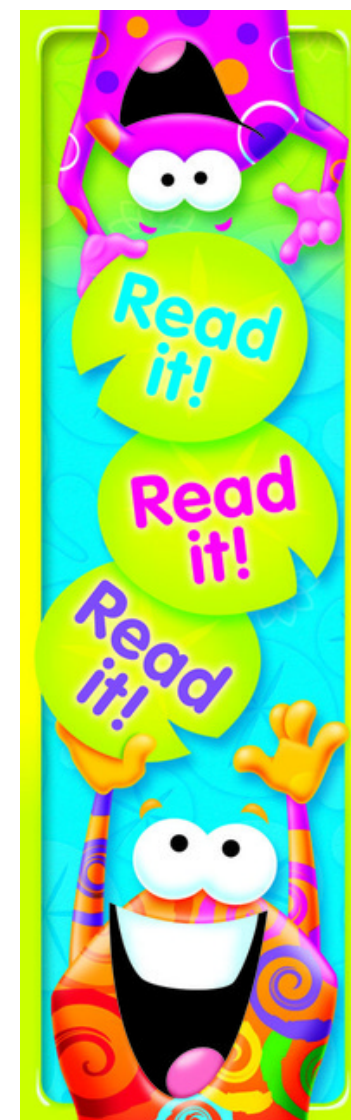

**ALL KINDERGARTEN**

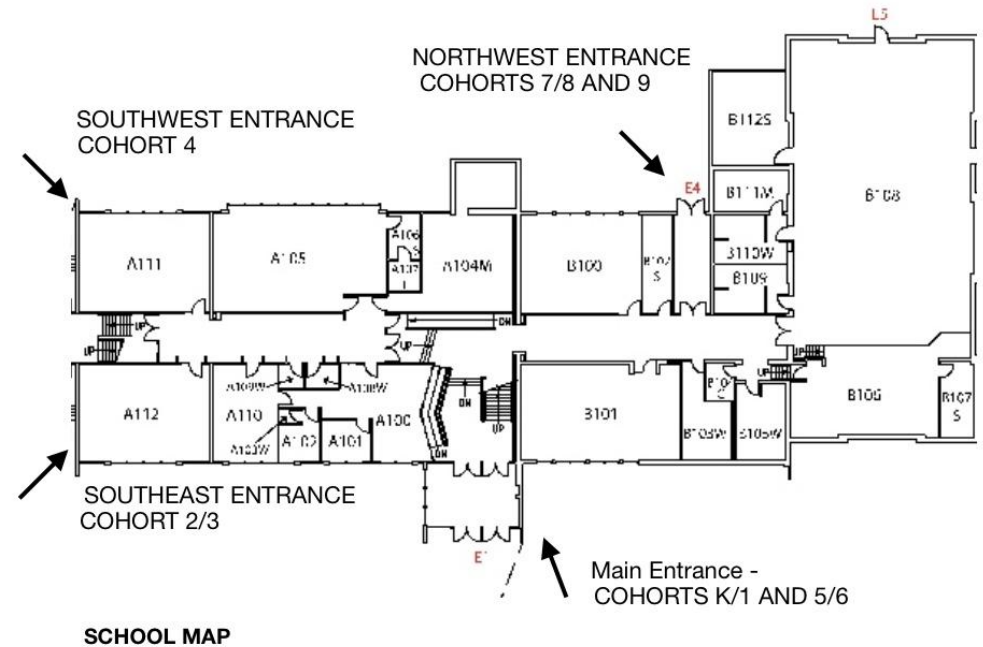
### Friday, September 3

### DESIGNATED COHORT ENTRY/EXIT POINTS

#### COHORTS K/1 AND 5/6

MAIN ENTRANCE - with the K/1 entering/exiting on the left and the 5/6 entering/exiting on the right.

#### COHORT 2/3

SOUTHEAST ENTRANCE (near the new kitchen)

#### COHORT 4/5

SOUTHWEST ENTRANCE (near the music room - facing the back parking lot)

#### COHORT 7/8 AND COHORT 9

NORTHWEST ENTRANCE (Jr. High boot room)
